



## **Charities That Have Benefited From Party With a Purpose**

### **January, 2010**

In 2010, the event was held at Gilley's Dallas. Proceeds from the event benefited Dallas Challenge, a Dallas charity dedicated to helping youth stay on the path to a bright future.

### **January, 2009**

In 2009, the event was held at the incredible House of Blues in New Orleans. Proceeds from the event benefited Payton's Play it Forward, a New Orleans charity that is dedicated to improving the lives of families and children in the area.

### **January, 2008**

Party With a Purpose was held at Experience Music Project (EMP) in Seattle. Proceeds from the event benefited The Moyer Foundation's *Camp Erin*, a nationwide network of bereavement camps designed for children ages 6-17 who have experienced the death of a loved one.

### **January, 2007**

In 2007, the event was held at This Is London, an elite night club in Toronto. Proceeds from the event benefited YOUTHLINK, a Toronto charity that offers counseling, job training, and residential services for vulnerable/street youth in the Greater Toronto Area.

### **January, 2006**

In 2006, the event was held at Finnigan's Wake Irish Pub in Philadelphia. Proceeds from the event benefitted the Eliza Shirley House, a Salvation Army of Philadelphia charity that provides emergency shelter services for homeless, single women and families.

### **January, 2005**

In 2005, the event was held at The Royal Hawaiian in Honolulu. Proceeds from the event benefitted HUGS, an organization dedicated to providing support and enhancing the quality of life for Hawaii's seriously ill children and their families.

### **January, 2004**

In 2004, the event was held at The Indiana Roof Ballroom in Indianapolis. Proceeds from the event benefitted Horizon House, a multi-service day center which provides a variety of professional and hospitable services that empower the homeless to develop self sufficiency and permanently end their homelessness.

### **January, 2003**

In 2003, the event was held at The House of Blues in Anaheim. Proceeds from the event benefitted The Orangewood Children's Foundation and Home, a facility which focuses on the ongoing needs of children in the foster care system, developing a wide range of activities, scholarships, support and programs to give every child every chance to succeed.



### **January, 2002**

In 2002, the event was held at The Wildhorse Saloon in Nashville. Proceeds from the event benefitted The Vanderbilt Children's Hospital, which is dedicated to high-level pediatric, subspecialty treatment, and trauma care. The hospital is also a teaching and research facility, training many of the future's top pediatric physicians.

### **January, 2001**

In 2001, the event was held at Level Night Club in Miami. Proceeds from the event benefitted The Belafonte Tacolcy Center, one of the largest, private non-profit youth service institutions in the Greater Miami area. The mission of the Belafonte Center is to provide a safe environment where children and families are encouraged to explore life's options, making positive choices that strengthen self and community.

### **January, 2000**

In 2000, the event was held at The Fillmore Theater in San Francisco. Proceeds from the event benefitted The Glide Foundation. The Glide Foundation offers nontraditional human service programs to meet the needs of a largely homeless population, those who are in addiction recovery, and very low income families, children, and youth.

### **January, 1999**

In 1999, the event was held at the Hard Rock Café in Orlando. Proceeds from the event benefitted Second Harvest Food Bank of Central Florida, a private, nonprofit organization that collects and distributes donated food to more than 450 nonprofit partner agencies in six Central Florida counties.

### **January, 1998**

In 1998, the event was held at Station Casino in Kansas City. Proceeds from the event benefitted City Union Mission, which provides warm beds, nutritious food, and a place of safety for thousands of poverty stricken and homeless men, women, and children.

### **January, 1997**

In 1997, the event was held at Acapulco Sam's in San Antonio. Proceeds from the event benefitted The San Antonio Food Bank, which fights hunger in Southwest Texas through food distribution, programs, education, and advocacy. The San Antonio Food Bank serves the City of San Antonio and 16 surrounding counties. Every week, the Food Bank provides assistance to more than 25,000 individuals facing emergency or financial calamity.

### **January, 1996**

In 1996, event was held at E Street Alley Restaurant & Dance Club in San Diego. Proceeds from the event benefitted Lowe's Gift Hunger Relief Program.

### **January, 1995**

In 1995, the event was held at Rupert's in Atlanta. Proceeds from the event benefitted Atlanta's Table. This nonprofit organization has been collecting prepared perishable food from their local hospitality industry and delivering food to more than 40 Metro Atlanta nonprofit partner agencies daily.
